Introduction

Welcome My name is _____ and I will be walking you through this session. I am going to read this off the paper directly, because I want to keep each study as similar as possible.

What is a usability test: We are testing an application to perform moderated usability tests.

Consider me neutral: We are testing the application, not you. You cannot do anything wrong, and you don't have to worry about making mistakes. We want to hear exactly what you think, so please don't worry that you're going to hurt our feelings. I am not the designer, I am neutral to the product. We want to improve it, so we need to know honestly what you think.

About recording sessions: With your permission, we're going to videotape the session and what you have to say. The video will be used only to help us figure out how to improve the application, and it won't be seen by anyone except the people working on this product. It also helps me because I don't have to take as many notes. There are also some people observing in the other room and taking notes.

What are we testing today: We are testing UX Gofer. UX Gofer is a software that helps users create a usability study from start of moderator guide to collecting data from live participants. It provides moderated usability testing as well as analytics for websites and other product types.

Speak aloud protocol: As we go along, I am going to ask you to think out loud, to tell me what's going through your mind. This will help us.

Participants rights: You have the right to take a break or withdraw from this test at anytime. and your data will be removed from the study. You have the right to ask questions and receive a copy of your sessions recording.

What is the Informed Consent: The informed consent is something that simply says that we have your permission to tape you, but that it will only be seen by the people working on this project. It also states that you won't talk to anybody about what we're showing you today, since it has not been made public yet.

Informed Consent

There will be cameras recording the session and you have the right to withdraw at any time during the session. The data will not be associated with any particular individual. All of the demographic data, and features and functionality data will be anonymous. All of the data will only be identified and linked together by a number, and will not be linked back to an individual in any way. There are no risks involved in participating in this study.
